Activities will include...

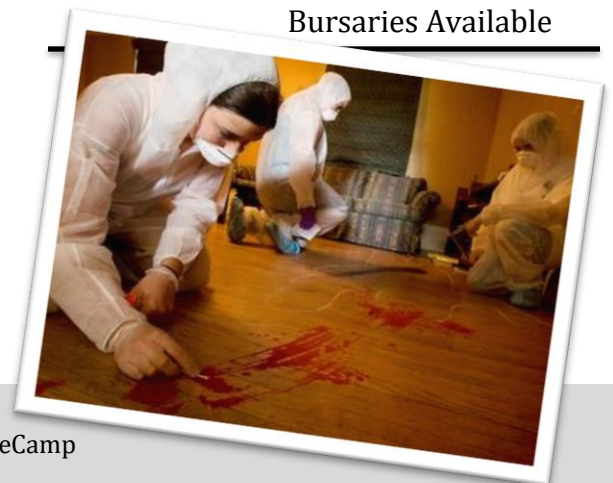
