Dear Parents/Guardians,

On January 26th you received an updated *Community Information Bulletin* from the DPCDSB outlining the transition from Quadmester 2 to Quadmester 3. This communication outlined the distribution of student Quadmester 3 timetables and final marks for Quadmester 2; provided you with our Quadmester 3 calendar; and referenced a future communication would be forthcoming regarding the collection and distribution of textbooks. Our textbook and learning materials collection procedure for Quadmester 2 courses will take place on **Thursday January 28th** and **Friday January 29th** between **1:00pm and 3:00pm**. Textbooks will be collected at the front exterior entrance of school. Students are asked to drop off Quadmester 2 textbooks and learning materials at designated course/subject area tables located outside school front entrance doors. Please label items returned with masking tape or sticky note with the student's name and grade, class and teacher *before you arrive at the school*.

Note: Social gatherings at the school will not be permitted. Any person accessing the school are to adhere to the following Peel Public Health Guidelines:

1) Self-Assessment and Screening

- Any person accessing a school should be directed to perform a COVID-19 self-assessment before arriving at the school. The Ministry of Health's self-assessment can be accessed here: <https://covid-19.ontario.ca/self-assessment/>
- **If the self-assessment directs you to stay home and monitor your health or to get tested for COVID-19, do not come to the school.**
- Entry shall be denied to any person who has any of the symptoms outlined in the 'COVID-19 Reference Document for Symptoms' on the Ministry of Health's COVID-19 website.

- Common symptoms of COVID-19 include fever (temperature of 37.8 greater), new or worsening cough, and shortness of breath.
- Other symptoms of COVID-19 can include sore throat, difficulty swallowing, new olfactory or taste disorders, nausea/vomiting, diarrhea, abdominal pain, etc.
- Entry shall also be denied to any person who has been in contact with anyone suspected or confirmed of having COVID-19 in the past 14 days.
- Although it is important to maintain physical distancing of 2 metres at all times, people must wear a non-medical mask/face covering.

2) Accessing the School

- Anyone accessing the building should do the following:
 - Clean their hands upon entry and upon exit with hand sanitizer.
 - Avoid touching their eyes, nose and mouth.
 - Cover a cough and sneeze with a tissue or arm, not a hand.
 - Maintain physical distancing of two metres from others.
- parents/guardians/students are asked to leave the building immediately after they have returned devices and other items belonging to the school.
- Persons are to stay only within the area(s) of the school they need to access and refrain from lingering.
- Use of washrooms and drinking fountains is not permitted.
- Persons are not be permitted to gather in groups on the school premises.
- Wearing of face coverings (e.g., cloth masks) is required.

We anticipate that the distribution of Quadmester 3 textbooks and learning materials will take place the week of February 8th. Teachers will continue to support remote learning through online resources throughout the first week of Quadmester 3 classes.
