Dear St. Anthony Families:

As you would be aware, we have experienced a number of COVID exposures among our students at St. Anthony recently, resulting in a significant number of classes being directed to self-isolate. These classes have transitioned to remote learning during the isolation period.

For those classes where students have not been directed to self-isolate, we continue to welcome these students to attend school for in-person learning. Moving forward, we will also offer our students the option to learn remotely for the remainder of this week and throughout next week with a tentative return to in-person learning for all on Friday, November 5. We will confirm the November 5 return date in a further communication to you next week.

If you would like your child(ren), who are not currently part of a class which is isolating, to learn remotely for the remainder of this week and next week, please contact the school and let us know.

Teachers will be in the school and will teach in either full remote or hybrid mode (teaching both in-person learners and remote learners simultaneously) during this time.

Thank you for your attention to this important information and again, please contact the school if you wish for your non-isolating child(ren) to learn remotely for the period up to November 5.
