Labour Relations Update: OECTA Enhanced Job Action

FOR ELEMENTARY PARENTS/GUARDIANS

February 10, 2020

The Ontario English Catholic Teachers' Association (OECTA) has indicated that it will initiate "enhanced administrative job action" across the province starting tomorrow, Tuesday, February 11 unless a tentative agreement is reached with the Ontario government and the Ontario Catholic School Trustees' Association.

This enhanced job action may affect some interschool student activities such as athletics and other competitions. Every effort will be made to maintain these activities. However, if your child's activity is cancelled or postponed, it would be because our student supervision options are impacted by the OECTA enhanced job action.

Our priority, as always, is the safety, security and well-being of students and staff. **At this time, ALL DPCDSB SCHOOLS WILL REMAIN OPEN with regular programming on Tuesday, February 11.** We will continue to assess the impact of OECTA sanctions with respect to the safe operation of our schools.
