Peel Public Health has confirmed with Student Transportation of Peel Region (STOPR) that it may resume its Courtesy Ridership program for Secondary School students effective the week of February 21. *Note that this applies to Secondary students only; Courtesy Ridership for Elementary students remains suspended.*

By way of background, under STOPR's Courtesy Seat Procedure (STOPR013), courtesy seats are considered on an annual basis by school administration. Courtesy seats can only be considered on regular bus routes and existing bus stops (Courtesy seats are not available on special needs buses/vans).

Parents/guardians who are interested in applying for courtesy ridership for their secondary school child(ren) are advised to visit the [STOPR website](#) to download a courtesy seat application form (TFL004) and submit the completed form to their school.

Starting the week of February 21, STOPR staff will begin the process of assigning courtesy riders.

Parents/guardians can direct any questions about secondary courtesy ridership to their child(ren)'s school.
