### DPCDSB Schools Closed on Monday, November 7 Transition to Synchronous Learning

November 4, 2022

Thank you for your continued patience and understanding as we respond to the ongoing provincial CUPE labour disruption.

We do not know, at this time, how long the labour disruption will continue. As indicated in our previous communications, we have been directed by the Ministry of Education to make a speedy switch to synchronous remote learning and are working to put the necessary pieces in place to make that happen as soon as we can.

In this regard, all DPCDSB schools will be closed to students **on Monday, November 7, 2022, and for the balance of any further job action by CUPE as we transition to synchronous remote learning.** As indicated previously, synchronous learning may take a day or two to become fully operational.

Please continue to reach out to your school if your child(ren) require a learning device. As previously communicated, there are limited devices available. For those who are unable to secure a device, a learning materials package will be provided that can be completed asynchronously during the coming days.

Please note the following **closures and cancellations** that remain in effect for the duration of the labour disruption:

- **All schools are closed to students:** DPCDSB educators will begin to transition to synchronous remote learning over the coming days.
- **All student transportation** is cancelled.
- **All childcare centres and before and after school programs** are closed. Please contact your childcare provider for more information.
- **All athletic and club events taking place in schools** are postponed.
- **All permits** are cancelled.
- **International Languages programs and other programs** which take place at DPCDSB schools are cancelled.

**Please Note: OFSSAA events occurring Friday, November 4 and the weekend will continue as scheduled.**
