The Dufferin-Peel Catholic District School Board is pleased with the Ministry of Education's recent funding announcement of \$10.3M for Holy Name of Mary Catholic Secondary School. The scope of the work approved by the Ministry includes:

- Demolition of the relocatable classroom module (RCM), which consists of the cafeteria, servery, classrooms, washrooms, workrooms and resources rooms;
- Construction of a two (2) story addition to replace the demolished RCM and additional classrooms to replace the existing portables on site;
- Modifications to the parking lot and site grading revisions.

While the project is still in its initial phase, we are committed to providing the school community with regular updates throughout the process.

The firm of Walter Fedy Architects was recently retained by the Board to refine the scope of work, design and develop the schedule for this project.

Due to the proposed scale of the project, we expect that the design and approval phase will take the entire 2018-19 school year to complete. We do not anticipate that the construction phase of the project will begin until the summer of 2019.

The impact on the students and staff at Holy Name of Mary, including whether they can be accommodated on-site during the construction phase, will be known once the design and work schedule have been finalized. As design work will take place this summer, we will have further information to share in the fall.
