Asymptomatic targeted testing expansion

The following options will be available to staff and students in the community.

→ IN-PHARMACY TESTING

Existing Pharmacies

- For the week of April 12-18 only, pharmacies that currently offer asymptomatic testing for education staff, will now accept appointments from students.
- Children attending childcare located within schools will also be eligible to access this testing. Please check with your local pharmacy on minimum testing age.
- While students/children can access testing in pharmacies for April 12-18 only, this testing will continue to be available for all staff.
- To book an appointment, visit the [Covid-19 Testing Locations website](#), and select “pharmacy” as your location type, with the booking details requested.

Assessment Centres

- For the week of April 12-18, students and staff will also be able to access asymptomatic testing at local assessment centres.
- Children attending childcare located within schools, and childcare staff, will also be eligible to access this testing.
- This testing is only being offered to students, children, and staff from April 12-18.
- To book an appointment, visit the [Covid-19 Testing Locations website](#), and select “assessment centre” as your location type, with the booking details requested.
