Dear Elementary DPCDSB Families:

In case you are still having difficulty understanding the Learning Options available to you as outlined in communications you received recently, we hope the following will be of help to you.

If you are currently attending in school and want to remain in-school, you don't have to complete the survey and you will automatically remain in the in-school setting, which will become part of the **HYBRID mode**. This also allows you the option to switch back and forth to a remote setting connected to your home school, where you will be learning together with classmates from your home school and at the same time.

If you want to remain in-school but wish to take the survey anyway, that is still ok and you would select the HYBRID MODE, where the same flexibility described above will apply.

If you are currently in remote learning and want to stay in remote learning (where you are not necessarily aligned with your home school or with classmates from your home school), **select the REMOTE MODE**.

If you are currently in remote and want an online learning option that also gives you the flexibility to change to in-school learning and in alignment with your home school and with other students from your home school, select the HYBRID MODE.

Remember, once the selection is made, there is a commitment to remain in that learning mode for the remainder of the 2020-2021 school year.
