#### **INVITATION TO ATTEND COMMUNITY OPEN HOUSE MEETING**

#### **HOLY NAME OF MARY ACCOMMODATION STRATEGY 2019/2020**

To Parents and Guardians:

On May 16, 2018 the Holy Name of Mary school community was informed that the Dufferin-Peel Catholic District School Board (DPCDSB) received funding approval from the Ministry of Education for the construction of an addition at Holy Name of Mary Catholic Secondary School. The approved scope of work includes:

- Demolition of the relocatable classroom module (RCM), which consists of the cafeteria, servery, classrooms, washrooms, workrooms and resources rooms;
- Construction of a two (2) story addition to replace the demolished RCM and additional classrooms to replace the existing portables on site;
- Modifications to the parking lot and site grading revisions.

Due to the scope of this construction project, Holy Name of Mary students will be temporarily relocated to a host location for the 2019/2020 school year during the construction period.
