The Dufferin-Peel Catholic District School Board (DPCDSB) is pleased to announce the official reopening of Holy Name of Mary Catholic Secondary School (CSS) on Monday, January 4, 2021 at its permanent location at 115 Glenvale Boulevard, Brampton.

Over the last 18 months, Holy Name of Mary CSS has undergone a significant transformation. The most significant change is the removal of the 17 portables and the one-story relocatable classroom module (RCM) which contained the cafeteria and classroom spaces. The RCM has been replaced with a two-story, 17-classroom addition which includes a new cafeteria. Improvements have also been made to the parking lot and kiss 'n ride area.

Since September 2019, Holy Name of Mary CSS students have been temporarily hosted at St. Kateri Tekakwitha Catholic Learning Commons (CLC) in Mississauga. All students will continue to remain with their existing classes and classroom teachers in January when they return to the Glenvale location.

The DPCDSB thanks the Holy Name of Mary CSS community for its patience and understanding during construction. While the school will be operational for use by students and staff on January 4, 2021, work to complete some minor details may be ongoing. This work will be scheduled during evenings and weekends.

Student Transportation

As communicated to students/parents/guardians prior to the relocation of Holy Name of Mary CSS to St. Kateri Tekakwitha (CLC), busing will no longer be provided by DPCDSB when Holy Name of Mary CSS students return to the Glenvale location. Previously, private busing had been arranged through the Holy Name of Mary CSS School Council.
