May our continued prayer rise to you and express our hope for the promise of a future of learning in faith.



LAND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

We begin by acknowledging the land and our responsibility to care for and respect all that Creation gives to provide us with life. Location and Site Details

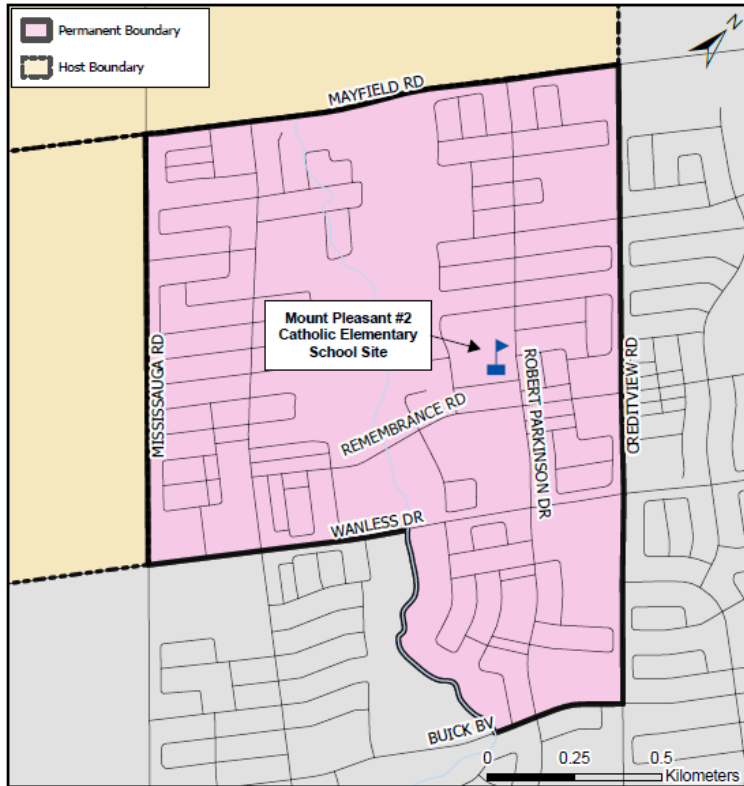
| 320 Robert Parkinson Drive

Permanent Boundary

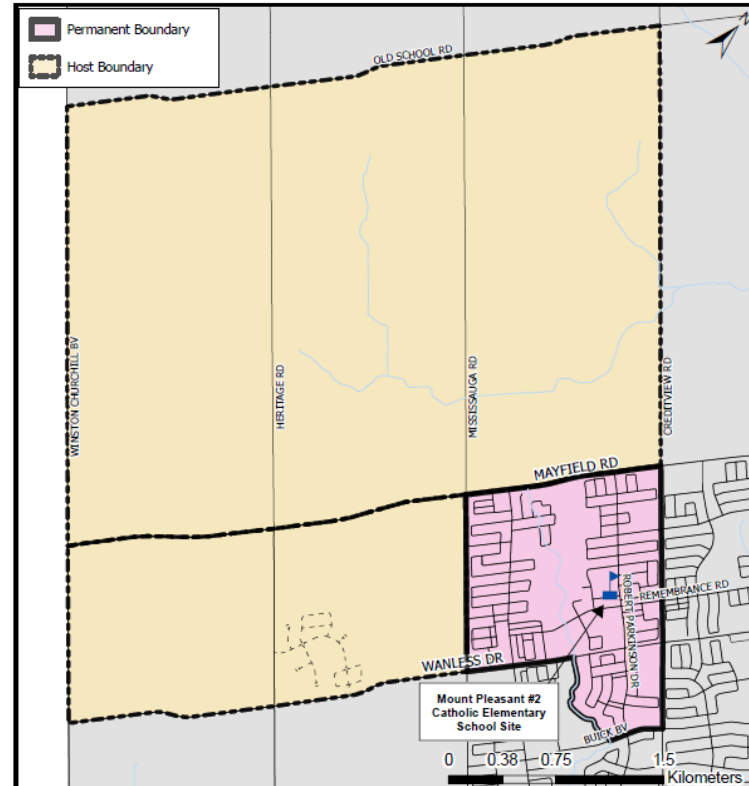
MOUNT PLEASANT #2 CATHOLIC ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PROPOSED BOUNDARIES

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Registration

| Existing DPCDSB students

Students directed to the new Mount Pleasant CES from St. Daniel Comboni and St. Aidan will be automatically transferred to the new school

If your child is attending a different DPCDSB school but live within the proposed school boundary, a transfer from your current school will be required

| Future DPCDSB students

If you live in the proposed boundary and your child is not currently attending a DPCDSB elementary school, please ensure you provide your contact information and follow the DPCDSB website for registration details www.dpcdsb.org

Kindergarten Registration

| Registration is on-going:

- Please register online at **www.dpcdsb.org**
- Select St. Daniel Comboni for the 2025-2026 school year

Eligibility for Transportation

| **Busing/walking boundary will be assessed in the spring**

Busing distances:

- Kindergarten to Grade 1: 1.0 km
- Grades 2 to 4: 1.6 km
- Grades 5 to 8: 2.0 km
- Secondary (9-12): 3.8 km

School Hours

| Determined in Early Summer

School hours are determined by the Transportation Department following busing/walking boundary assessment

Child Care Programs

| Before and After School Program (BASP)

- Tender process to select an operator begins in early spring
- Pre-qualified operators may choose to bid on the site
- Principal and parent representatives will have input into operator selection
- Families will be advised once the process is complete

| Child Care Centre

The same operator will run both the BASP and the child care centre

General Questions & Answers

Will the school open on time?

- *Based on the current construction timelines the school is scheduled to open as planned*

What happens if the school is not ready on time?

- *If there are unforeseen circumstances that delay the opening of the school on September 2, the school community will be formed and hosted at another location until the new school opens.*

How will information on the school opening be communicated?

- *Information will be shared through St. Daniel Comboni CES and St. Aidan CES via Community Information Bulletins which will also be available on the board website*

General Questions & Answers

What is the name of the new school?

- *The new school's name is yet to be determined. A survey on the school naming will be sent to parents and guardians of students residing within the new school boundary at a later date.*

Can my child stay at St. Daniel Comboni?

- *Students entering grade 8 in September will have the option to remain at St. Daniel Comboni CES to complete their final year. All other students will be directed to the new school, including siblings of grade 8 students.*
- *Transportation will not be provided to grade 8 students that elect to stay.*
