Further to the initial positive COVID-19 case I informed you of earlier, Peel Public Health is investigating an additional COVID-19 exposure where a second person who was recently at our school has tested positive for COVID-19.

As part of their investigation, Peel Public Health will contact anyone determined to be a close contact. Only students and staff who are symptomatic or advised by Peel Public Health need to get tested.

Our building is safe and open for students and staff. The school has been cleaned many times since the exposures as part of our enhanced cleaning protocol. Peel Public Health will let us know if any other measures need to be taken to reduce the risk of transmission.

Keeping you informed is part of our commitment to you. Keeping personal information private, including the identity of the persons, is part of our commitment, too. I know this may frustrate you, but this is also part of Ontario's privacy laws. It protects anyone already sick or at risk.
