From our Chaplain...

The final month of the School Year

The month of May dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary is followed by the month of June dedicated appropriately to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. In anticipation of this His Eminence Cardinal Thomas Collins addressed a Pastoral Letter to the Faithful focused specifically on the devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and what can we learn from it for this time of pandemic that we find ourselves in. In his letter he also states: *"Quite apart from the pandemic, these are indeed days of suffering, with so much conflict in the world, and such contention in civil society. Across the globe refugees flee oppressive regimes, and the blood of martyrs rebukes us in our comfortable Christianity. In our own country, social trends antagonistic to the Gospel gather strength. Anger mounts in the social media, in political discourse, and sometimes in the streets. Even in the Church, and especially in the Church, we cannot escape from the tides of acrimony... In the face of all that, we listen even more intently to Our Lord: "Come to me, all you who labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me; for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. (Matthew 11:28-29)"*

At the conclusion of the letter he states: *"I strongly encourage individuals, families, parishes and Catholic schools to specially dedicate the month of June to the Sacred Heart. This he follows with practical suggestions for the Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. His Eminence says that: "The prayers of the Sacred Heart take us deep into the heart of our self, and lead us to God. We do not find confusing and over-complex intellectuality, but a simple "heart to heart" with the Lord, in the silence of our hearts."*

Therefore, as a school community each morning we will be praying a Novena to the Sacred Heart of Jesus beginning on June 3 and ending on Friday, June 11, the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. I invite you and encourage you to read the Cardinal's letter and then choose one or more of the practical suggestions that the Cardinal offers on pages 17 and 18 to form and follow your devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus during the month of June. May all our prayerful devotions to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus bring much healing and peace. *Deacon Frendo*
