Course Description	<p><i>This course enables students to develop understanding of the theoretical, social, and historical underpinning of various equity and social justice issues and to analyze strategies for bringing about positive social change—using a Catholic School perspective. Students will learn about historical and contemporary equity and social justice issues in Canada and globally. They will explore power relations and the impact of a variety of factors on equity and social justice.
