DANCE AUDITION BREAK DOWN:

Part 1: Dance Class

Participants will take part in a dance class centered on coordination, musicality, spatial awareness and the willingness to take risks. The class will feature center exercises and traveling across the floor.

Part 2: Dance Solo

Dancers will prepare and present a one-minute solo in a dance style of their choice. Students will provide the music on a phone or laptop and if needed, music can be emailed to kristyn.gwiazda@dpcdsb.org. This solo can be choreographed by themselves, by a friend, by a dance teacher, etc.

Part 3: Guided Improvisation

Students will be led through a variety of movement tasks to encourage new movement dynamics.

Part 4: Interview

This is a time for us to get to know the students. they will be provided a list of questions to answer and have the opportunity to ask any questions about our school or program.

INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC AUDITION BREAKDOWN:

Part 1: Group Masterclass Workshop

Participate with other candidates to assess your ability to collaborate and engage in musical activities.

Part 2: Interview

Use this time to discuss your music background and experiences. Be prepared to talk about your interests and why you want to join the program. You do not need to have concert band experience coming into the program but instead emphasize your passion for learning and growing in music. You may showcase your performance abilities on the piano, guitar, bass or percussion if applicable, but not necessary. A band instrument will be assigned to you once accepted into the program.

VOCAL MUSIC AUDITION BREAKDOWN:

Part 1: Group Masterclass Workshop

This will involve group exercises, warm-ups, and feedback from instructors. Be prepared to collaborate and showcase your skills in a group setting.

Part 2: Interview

This is a time for us to get to know the students. Use this time to discuss your music background and experiences. Be prepared to talk about your interests and why you want to join the program. Emphasize your passion for learning and growing in music

Part 3: Acapella Vocal Performance “O Canada”

Practice singing it confidently. Focus on pitch, tone, and expression, as this will be a straightforward assessment of your vocal ability.

Part 4: Song of Your Choice

Select a piece that shows your strengths. Ensure it aligns with the allowed genres (musical theatre, jazz, classical, or pop). Prepare to convey emotion and character in your performance. You may use a recorded accompaniment.
