STUDENT EXAMS: January 24-30, 2024

A. Procedures and Expectations

- Check the exam schedule very carefully and note the dates, times and locations of your exams.
*Refer to back page.
- Upon arriving, students are expected to be in their exam room, in full uniform, by 8:10 a.m
- Notes, texts, PEDs etc. are not to be used during the exam unless approved by the course teacher. Students are to adhere to the teacher's expectations regarding the location of these items while the exam is being written.
- Students are to remain in their exam location until 10:30 am at which time they can leave the school or attend study hall in the cafeteria until the buses leave at the end of the school day.

B. Academic Dishonesty

Academic dishonesty is a very serious offence and will result in the loss of some or all the exam portion of your final mark.

C. Textbooks and Course Materials

Students must return all texts/materials issued by your teacher up to the morning of the exam date. Students who do not have the textbook/course materials or the replacement cost to pay for these school materials will be sent to the Main Office. Parents will be contacted and no additional time will be granted if exam time is missed.

D. Absence from an Exam

Absence due to illness must be verified by a medical certificate. An unverified absence will result in a zero being assigned for the exam portion of your final mark.

E. Late for an Exam

If late for an exam, students must first report to the Attendance Office. The exam must be completed in the time remaining – additional time will not be provided.

F. Uniform

Full uniform must be worn during exam days. Students not in proper uniform will be sent to the office and may not be permitted to write their exam until they are in proper uniform. Extra time will not be provided for students who are late beginning their exam as a result of a uniform infraction.

G. Food Services

The cafeteria will be closed for lunch throughout the exam period. Cafeteria services will resume on Friday, February 2, 2024.

H. Buses

Normal morning and afternoon bus pick-up times will be in effect during the exam schedule and exam review day.

I. Inclement Weather

In the event that due to inclement weather, buses for All Dufferin-Peel Schools or schools in the City of Mississauga – Zone 1 are cancelled or if buses are cancelled and schools are closed for Dufferin-Peel, exams which are to be written that day will be postponed until the Contingency Exam Day on Tuesday, January 30, 2024.
