

Regional Arts and Culture Program (RAP) Information

Students will enter grade 9 and enroll in an Arts Discipline Course (Drama, Instrumental Music, Visual Art or Vocal). If they have enjoyed the course and want to pursue it, they will partake in an intake process/audition and declare their intent to enroll in the **Regional Arts and Culture Program (RAP)** in Grade 10. Once enrolled, students will take 2 art credits each year (one each semester) in their chosen discipline. They may continue in this program until completion of their grade 12 year. Upon graduation, in addition to an Ontario Secondary School Diploma, students will receive a Regional Arts and Culture Program Certificate.

Please note that the Dance Program has an audition process for Grade 9, please see the requirements for it.
