1. Research Component / Background of Program
 - This is the: what, why, who, where, when, how
 - Should be comprehensive . . .
 - Possible guiding questions:
 - When was it established?
 - Who / how many does it support?
 - Is it a non-profit organization? Who supports it staying afloat?
 - Who is affected? In what ways?
 - Why is the work important?
 - Etc.
 - Promotional videos outlining the company or cause in study are suggested

2. Are there any global comparisons / information that come out of your research?
 - E.g., comparison of homelessness in Toronto vs. major cities worldwide
 - E.g., level of poverty / need in countries where product is being sent
