Domino's Pizza Fundraiser Update

Planters for front of school

- Per L. Choporis we must follow the purchasing protocols of the school board and we must use one. A new vendor given by the board to L. Choporis seems promising from Dumor.com. The planters are steel and durable. They will be priced out and if the cost is agreeable council has agreed to be purchase if around \$1000.00 mark.

Fundraisers

Poinsettias

- we are approved to do a back door gym fundraiser. Bradford Greenhouses has spots available if we want to go ahead with it. Multiple options for purchase, the cheapest is \$5.50 ranging up to \$30.00. Minimum order required for free delivery is \$750.00, and the delivery would be between the last week of November or the first week of December between Tuesday to Friday and come in pink, red or white. The last time we hosted this fundraiser, we limited the selection of sizes and colours available for people to buy. To simplify stick with 6" of red and white and 10" tropical. Perhaps ask lunchtime supervisors to help. Minimizing choices will help in the sorting. Kristina will verify if we can secure the second week of December
