Dear Parents and Guardians,

To prepare our students for writing the Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test (OSSLT) during April and May 2022, we are offering an after-school Reading and Writing Skills Development program that will help our students prepare for the OSSLT. The program is designed to help students improve their reading and writing skills and further familiarize students with the OSSLT format.

***Who will be writing the OSSLT this session?:***

- Grade 10 students (both in-person learners and remote-only learners)
- Grade 11 students who did not write in the Fall 2021 session
- Grade 11 students who were unsuccessful in the Fall 2021 session
- Non-graduating Grade 12 students

\* All current Grade 10, Grade 11 and non-graduating Grade 12 students must pass the OSSLT to graduate from high school.

***When will the after-school Reading and Writing Skills Development program be offered?:***

- Monday March 28, 2022 – Thursday March 31, 2022 (inclusive)
- 2:45pm – 4:00pm

***How will the after-school Reading and Writing Skills Development program be delivered?:***

- In-person, for in-person learners, with a virtual option for remote-only learners.

Enrollment in this program is limited. We will do our best to accommodate all those who wish to participate, however enrolment in the program is on a first come, first served basis.
