**Changes to Grade 9 Curriculum:**
  - **NEW Science, Grade 9, De-streamed Course (SNC1W)** will be issued in Spring 2022 and it will be implemented in September 2022. This course will replace Science, Grade 9, Academic (SNC1D) and Science, Grade 9, Applied (SNC1P).
  - **English, Grade 9, Academic (ENG1D)** will be offered using the Academic course and course code (ENG1D) for the 2022-23 school year. The Applied course (ENG1P – English, Grade 9, Applied) will expire at the end of the 2021-22 school year.
  - **Issues in Canadian Geography, Academic (CGC1D)** Issues in Canadian Geography will be offered using the current Academic course and course code (CGC1D) for the 2022-23 school year. The Applied course (CGC1P – Issues in Canadian Geography, Grade 9, Applied) will expire at the end of the 2021-22 school year.
  - **French as a Second Language (FSF1D – Core French, Grade 9, Academic; FEF1D – Extended French, Grade 9, Academic; FIF1D – French Immersion, Grade 9, Academic)**
