1. Members in Attendance:

2. Review of Minutes from last meeting – motion to accept, 1st Terry, 2nd Theresa
3. Principal's Comments – Provided by Wayne Brunton
 - Next steps were in place re a new principal
 - Regarding cheques – Mrs. Scardichio normally signs the cheques and the bank would not allow Wayne to sign them, her son was to bring in a letter – should only take two weeks once letter received, current cheques would get signed
 - Asked us to thank all parents for their patience with all that was happening
 - Re Audio system – March 20th Ryan Mallia and Wayne were meeting at the school to review system and get an idea of cost, it should be well below 10K quote we had gotten, and it will still include upgrades to the system – some money will come from council and the balance will be covered by the school budget

 - Wayne mentioned that there are a shortage of principals in the school board and that is why they draw from the retiree pool of principals
