- 1. Edward King Memorial Award – Graduation – Certificate - \$100.00**  
(established in May 1992)

This award was established by the Secondary School Principals' Association to honour the contribution of leadership of Edward King, Principal of Father Goetz S.S. who died in April of 1992. This award is given to a student in the graduating class of all secondary schools who demonstrates academic excellence and leadership in the school programme.

- 2. Thomas J. Reilly Scholarship - Graduation - Certificate - \$100.00**  
(established June 1996)

This scholarship was established in recognition of the contribution of Tom Reilly as Director of Education upon his retirement in 1995. This award is presented annually in every secondary school to a graduating student who has demonstrated excellence in the study of a modern language and intends to pursue post secondary education.

- 3. Hazel McCallion Bursary – Graduation – Certificate - \$200.00**  
(established April 2006)

This annual bursary was established by Solel Congregation of Mississauga, honouring Mayor Hazel McCallion upon her 25<sup>th</sup> year of leadership in the City of Mississauga.

The bursary is given to the graduating student who has achieved the highest mark in Grade 12 Organizational Behaviour and Human Resources University/College Preparation Course. This course was chosen by the Committee since it emulates the leadership of Mayor Hazel McCallion. This course has a large leadership component as well as focusing on fiscal responsibility and ethical business practice.

- 4. Joe Hugel Award - Grade 10 student - Certificate - \$100.00**  
(established by the Board in 1983)

The Dufferin-Peel Roman Catholic District School Board established the Joe Hugel Award in honour of its first Director of Education. The award was given to a grade 10 student because government funding of the school system was limited to this grade in its early beginning. The Awards Committee assumed the sponsorship of this award in June of 1996. This award is given to the grade 10 student in every secondary school with the highest overall final average.
