Computer Studies – Computer studies, Computer Programming, Computer Science, Web Development

Co-operative Education – Gain real world experience in a career, an apprenticeship, or for general interest. Loyola offers 2, 3 and 4 credit options. Co-op Certificates awarded upon completion of workplace hours.

Dual Credits – students can take 1, 2 or 3 college courses with other high school students and attend at the college 1, 2 or 3 days of the week. Bussing and Tuition is provided.
