School Calendar:

Uniforms:

R.J. McCarthy is the official DPCDSB uniform supplier. All uniform items, with the exception of socks and shoes, must be purchased from McCarthy's. McCarthy's has a retail store in Oakville located at 2501 Beryl Rd., Phone No. 416-593-6900. The Oakville store is open throughout the summer months. We would encourage you to place your order earlier rather than wait until late August as that will be a very busy time at the store given that the store services numerous schools. McCarthy's also has an on-line service: www.mccarthyuniforms.ca. **Shoes must be all black, all white, or a combination of the two with a closed heel and toe.** Running, casual or dress shoes are advised for the safety of all students. All non-uniform items such as jackets, sweatshirts and hats must be stored in student lockers during the school day. Please refer to the Student Handbook for further details.
