Tuesday June 29 - 2021 Graduation Activities

St. Martin Graduate and Family,

We have endeavored to make the graduation ceremony as interactive as possible while still adhering the COVID19 safety protocols. All line-ups will have taped or marked off areas to enforce social distancing. Security will be on site throughout the day to manage traffic.

In order to make the day memorable and safe for all graduating students, parents and staff, we ask for your co-operation in following the following guidelines:

Anyone entering the building or coming to the school will be required to wear a mask at all times, hand sanitize and maintain physical distancing of two meters from others. Please note the use of washrooms and drinking fountains will not be permitted.

Parents will drop students off at the main entrance and proceed to park at the back of the school and then make their way to a dedicated “photography area” by the bleachers by the football field.

In the meantime, students will hand in any textbooks or technology, and leave the building immediately and line up in queue in front of the bleachers, where staff will “cheer them through”.

Students will receive their diploma from the administrative team, on a podium on the field and then proceed to a station to pick up their gift bags, awards, certificates, etc. A professional photographer will take photos of each student receiving their diploma.

Student and parents will then proceed to the back of the school, where an additional dedicated photo area will be setup, where families will have a few minutes to take a group photo, and a picture with the admin team.

We ask students and parents to remain only within the designated area(s) of the school and refrain from lingering. Gathering in groups on the school premises will not be permitted.

Once photos are completed families will then drive out of the parking lot; some staff will be invited to “clap out” the students and their family as they exit the school grounds.

In case of inclement weather, the diploma presentation will occur in the gym, and the photographer(s) will be moved indoors to capture the event.
