

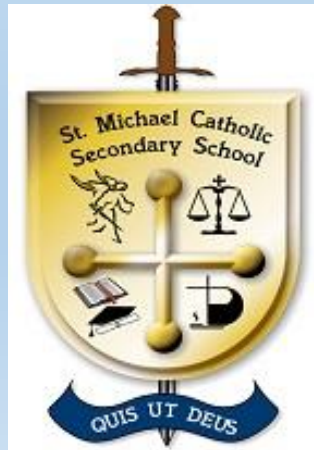



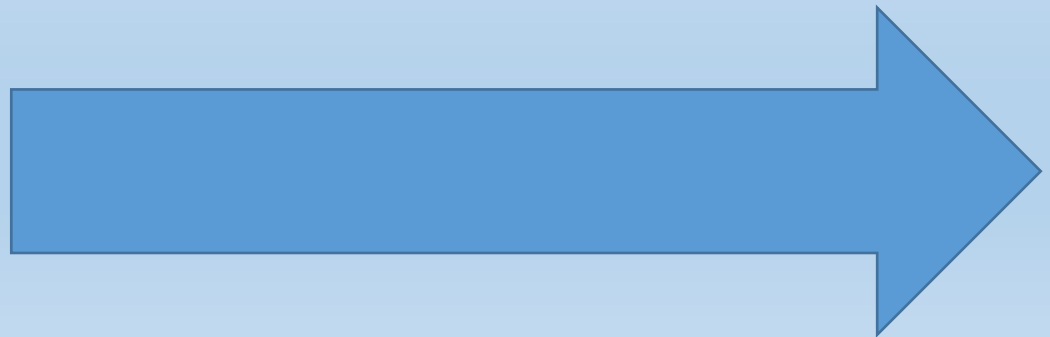

How to replace a compulsory course with an elective course

In order to graduate from high school, every student needs to complete certain compulsory courses in order to meet the Ontario Secondary School Diploma requirements. Most often, these courses are taken during the school year, however some students choose to take these courses in the summer in order to take an additional elective course during the school year.

STEP 1

When making your course selections, you first need to ADD the compulsory course (ex. Civics and Careers) as one of your selections


STEP 2

Once the Civics/Careers course is added, you need to change the course and select the elective course that you wish to take. This is done by clicking the 3 dots found beside the “Career Studies/Civics” course name.

STEP 3


After clicking the 3 dots, a box with 3 options will appear. Select the “change” option.





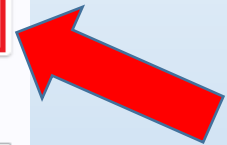
