Step 3 - Must forward their completed registration form (from Step 1) to their Guidance Counsellor for review and approval.

DPCDSB offers Secondary Summer School courses under the OSS curriculum guidelines. Parents and students consult with their day school guidance counsellor regarding diploma requirements, course selections and prerequisite courses. IMPORTANT DPCDSB SECONDARY SUMMER SCHOOL GUIDELINES AND INFORMATION - PLEASE READ

ELIGIBLE STUDENTS: Students must be currently enrolled in a Secondary School program for admission to the Secondary Summer School Program, July 2021 and must apply directly through their guidance office.

The student must have the required prerequisite (where necessary) and the signed approval from the Principal/Designate.

CRASP (CREDIT RECOVERY ALTERNATIVE SUMMER PROGRAM)

- Students who failed a course with a mark of 40-49% have an opportunity to earn credit under this program. Students may sign up for sessions that will run **July 5 to 16 or July 19 to 30, 2021.**
- Students who failed a course with a mark of 0-39% can earn the credit by registering for the 4-week summer course from **July 5 to July 30, 2021.**
- Ensure that the conditions outlined above are met when you sign off on the registration forms. Marks will be double-checked.

UPGRADING MARKS

- Students upgrading marks need to register for the 4-week summer course from **July 5 to July 30, 2021.**
- Please ensure that the conditions outlined above are met when you sign off on the registration forms. Marks will be double-checked.

FINAL ASSESSMENT: Students must write/complete their final assessment at the end of the program, on the date and time set out by the Adult and Continuing Education Department. **Students who miss the scheduled final assessment will receive a mark of zero for the assessment**
