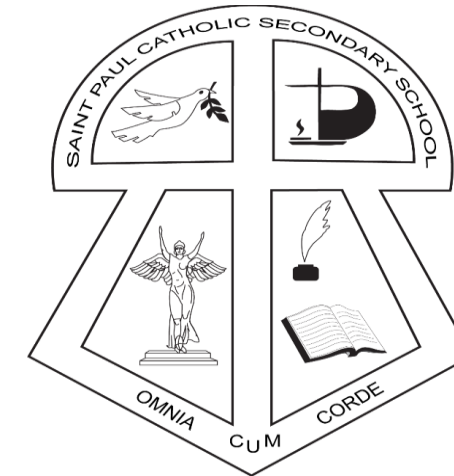

- DUAL CREDIT COURSES:** A wide variety of College Dual Credit Courses are available for senior students. Dual Credit Programs are run through co-op. Please check the school website for list of program options.
- INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE PREPARATORY COURSES (IB)** are indicated by the sixth character “B” – Sample: ENG 1DB (Grade Nine English – IB Prep.).
- INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE COURSES Year 1 (Gr. 11) and Year 2 (Gr. 12)** are indicated by the sixth character “S” for Standard Level and “H” for Higher Level.
- CO-OP** programs run ½ day in the morning OR afternoon (2 credit) or full day (4 credit) in both semesters; co-op credits cannot be used to apply to university.
