Dear Parents/Guardians and Students:

Please see below for important information regarding the Semester 2 Examination Period for St. Roch students.

1. **Students must be in full uniform for all examinations.** Any time spent getting into uniform will impact on the time remaining for the exam and students will not be given additional time to write their exam.
2. **Textbook Collection Process:** All outstanding textbooks/materials and/or replacement fees will be collected before each exam begins.
3. A student who misses an examination must provide a doctor's note and a parental note confirming the illness and the duration. Please inform the school (905-456-8543 ext.26007) before the scheduled exam(s). Students who miss an exam without providing the school with a medical note stating they are unable to write the exam will be assigned a mark of 0% for the exam component of the evaluation. Students who do provide a medical note **may** still be required to write an examination based on the recommendation from the subject teacher in consultation with the principal. Notification must be given by the parent by the end of that exam day.
4. **All students must be in the designated Exam Room by 8:07 am.**
5. Students must come equipped with their own rulers, pencils, pens, etc. No sharing will be allowed, so bring extras. Materials such as texts, notes, binders, pencil cases, etc. must be left at the front of the room and not beside your desk.
6. Students who are late should report directly to the exam room. Students who are late for the exam will not be given any additional time to write the exam.
7. No students are permitted to leave an exam prior to 10:30 a.m.
8. **The cafeteria will be closed during the examination period.**
9. In addition to these expectations, classroom teachers will provide additional classroom instructions as they pertain to textbooks, materials allowed, etc.
10. Please check your schedule carefully and know the rooms and times for each of your exams. **Exam review day will take place on Tuesday June 27, 2023.** You will have an opportunity to review your final exams on this day. You must report to school **in uniform**. There will be no cafeteria services on this day.
11. **IF** all schools in Dufferin-Peel are CLOSED due to any unforeseen circumstance, on any exam day, that exam will be written on Monday, June 26<sup>th</sup>.
