Opening Prayer	Opening Prayer by Rana Sawaya <u>Land Acknowledgment</u> We begin by acknowledging the land and our responsibility to care for and respect all that Creation gives to provide us with life. This land upon which we live, work and sustain ourselves is the ancestral and treaty lands of the Michizaagiig Anishinaabek also known today as the Mississaugas of the Credit, the rightful caretakers and titleholders of this land. We also recognize that this land is rich in pre-contact history and relationships, which includes the Anishinaabek and Onkwehonwe and since European contact has and continues to become home for Indigenous and non-Indigenous peoples. As a responsible community we believe all people are sacred and possess inherent and immeasurable worth and dignity. Colonialism displaced and dispossessed Indigenous Peoples of their ancestral lands and continues to deny their basic human rights, dignities and freedoms. We are committed to the sacrament of reconciliation, making reparations and fulfilling our treaty obligations, duties and responsibilities as outlined in the Gdoo-naaganinaa (Dish with One Spoon) wampum. This treaty governs and affirms that we actively maintain mutually beneficial relationships and collectively respect and care for the land, water, animals and each other in order to guarantee a good life for our future descendants.

PLASP has begun the process to get it licensed again • Kiss 'n Ride – encouraging drivers to slow down when driving through the Kiss 'n Ride. We are also reminding parents not to leave their cars unattended in the Kiss 'n Ride lanes so that we can keep traffic moving. • Classes were very competitive with the fundraiser. So far we have more than doubled the goal raising so far, \$7432.00. • Mrs. Di Vito applied for and received a \$2000 grant for Scientists in the school, this will reduce the amount students will have to pay, unless CSC would like to pay the remainder • Mme. Habashy applied for a Discount from CapeTown.
