# IMPORTANT DPCDSB SUMMER SCHOOL GUIDELINES



## ELIGIBLE STUDENTS

Students who are currently enrolled in a Secondary School program are eligible for admission to the Summer School Program and must apply directly through their guidance office. All applicants who are NOT currently attending a day school may apply in person to the Adult and Continuing Education Office - St. Gabriel Office, 3750 Brandon Gate Drive. Mississauga OR fax registration form and all documents to: 905 362-0706.

Grade 8 students entering Grade 9 in September 2017 are not eligible to take courses.

## CRASP (CREDIT RECOVERY ALTERNATIVE SUMMER PROGRAM)

- Students who failed a course with a mark of 40-49% have an opportunity to earn credit under this program. Students may sign up for sessions that will run July 4 to 17 or July 18 to 31, 2017
- Students who failed a course with a mark of 0-39% can earn the credit by registering for the 4-week summer course from July 4 to 31, 2017

## UPGRADING MARKS

- Students upgrading marks need to register for the 4-week summer course from July 4 to 31, 2017.

Please ensure that the conditions outlined above are met when you sign off on the registration forms. Marks will be double-checked.

If the applicant has an Individual Education Plan (IEP) they must provide a copy to program teacher.
